Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation requires consent of affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees.
- (2) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (3) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) Operation in the 1695-1780 MHz, 1915-1920 MHz, 1995-2020 MHz or 2110-2200 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (6) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (7) Georgia Institute of Technology must obtain the consents of the following licensees within 80 km of the test area: Location & Monitoring Service licensees (902-928 MHz); and 1392-1395 MHz/1432-1435 MHz Band licensees.
