Subject: Request for Info - STA File # 0582-EX-ST-2005

Message:

The differentiation between Form 442 and Special Temporary Authority (STA) is not one of purpose, but one of duration. STAs are to be applied for whenever the expected duration of testing is six months or less. Under extenuating circumstances, such as a delay in obtaining equipment in your case, we are willing to extend STAs. I will extend 0582-EX-ST-2005 for this purpose. If you intend to operate at Los Gatos long term, then the filing of a request for regular experimental license, such as 0288-EX-PL-2005, is proper. Any beta tests at other locations can be filed as STAs if it is expected that the testing at those locations will be for six months or less, and you may file for more than one location per STA.

After you respond to this email answering the questions I still have, I will grant 0582-EX-ST-2005.

- 1) You did file 0288-EX-PL-2005 for Los Gatos, but for only 12 months. Standard licenses are for 24 months. If you really only need it for 12 months, that is what it will be considered for. A regular experimental license will need to be re-coordinated. Do you still want the regular license, and do you still want it only for 12 months?
- 2) Will the beta tests at future sites be for less than six months? If not, regular licenses will be needed for them. If regular licenses are needed, you may file as a modification for the license you obtain for 0288-EX-PL-2005, if you proceed with that filing.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 06, 2005 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
