The experimental application is requesting use of the following amateur radio High Frequency bands;

Request 5005 - 6210 kHz MO Conflicts 60m Amateur Band 5330.5 - 5403.5 Mhz 3000W 50K0V2D Various

Request 6320 - 8250 kHz MO Conflicts 40m Amateur Band 7000.0 - 7300 Mhz 3000W 50K0V2D Various

Given the wideband nature of the transmissions/experimentation and the use in the entire United States the transmissions are likely to cause significant interference to the amateur radio bands they will occupy. I object to the issuance of this experimental license.
