Please provide your response to the following concern raised by FCC Mass Media Bureau staff:

"As far as I can tell, the applicant doesn't mention the possibility of interference to adjacent channel full-service TV station KVOA (Channel 4) in Tucson, which is the local NBC affiliate. We might have a problem here and I I would certainly urge caution. Perhaps the applicant could be asked why there would be no conflict to reception of channel 4 in the Tucson area. By way of analogy, the LPTV rules do not permit an adjacent channel translator or LPTV station of any power level inside the Grade B contour of an adjacent channel TV station."

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 01, 2001 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
