Special Conditions:

- (5) The operation will be coordinated with all operators of satellites that use the same frequency bands and are in the relocation path. All operators of satellites in the path will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be in the event that harmful interference occurs.
- (6) Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.

- (8) The licensee of this authorization must successfully coordinate with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in 29250-30000 MHz band.
