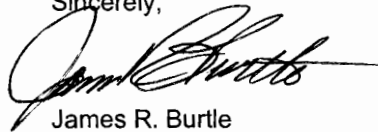
Dear 1127 Auraria,

This refers to application, File No. 0182-EX-PL-2010, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. The application you are seeking is not possible at this time due to policy issues associated with use of the GPS frequencies. We recommend that you review the Agency Roles and Responsibilities portion of the U.S. SPACE-BASED POSITIONING, NAVIGATION, AND TIMING POLICY located at <http://pnt.gov/policy/2004-policy.shtml> to determine how your proposed operation using GPS frequencies could be supported under those guidelines. The license you are seeking would require the agreement of those agencies tasked with implementation of those policies. If you believe that your application could be supported under this policy, you should contact the National Coordination Office for Space Based PNT (<http://pnt.gov/office/>) to discuss the possibility of receiving support of the National Executive Committee for Space-Based Positioning, Navigation, and Timing.
