I see nothing in the importation rules in Part 2, Subpart K about an experimental license as a requisite to importation of foreign equipment. Either Motorola is allowed to import the equipment under one or more of the conditions of 47CFR2.1204 or they aren't. In any case, they cannot SELL unauthorized equipment to you.

We do not like to set precedent for granting an experimental license where none is necessary. If you are not requesting authority to transmit, then no license is necessary, and none will be granted.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 24, 2008 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
