

REQUEST FOR EXPERIMENTAL LICENSE

Group O (“Group O”), pursuant to Section 5.54(a) of the Commission’s rules, hereby requests a conventional experimental radio station license.¹ The purpose of this request is to allow Group O to operate GPS signal repeaters within its labs in order to inspect and evaluate electronic devices using GPS radios. As set forth below, grant of this request will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Group O is a leading provider of managed products and services, specializing in marketing services, print management, business analytics, decisions sciences, business process outsourcing, managed services, packaging, supply chain management and third-party logistics. Among other things, Group O operates equipment laboratories in which it conducts first article inspections and receiving inspections of various electronic devices, such as smart phones, watches and other accessories. Specifically, Group O samples and tests equipment destined for sale by its customers to validate functionality and to ensure performance within design specifications. Group O proposes to operate GPS repeaters at three of its labs in order to facilitate the testing of equipment utilizing GPS radios.

All equipment operated under the authority of the requested experimental license will be subject to the supervision and control of Group O at all times. Group O will operate the equipment only within the confines of its laboratories, pursuant to authorized technical parameters and applicable conditions. Given that the purpose of the requested STA is to facilitate the testing and evaluation of electronic devices to ensure proper operation, Group O respectfully submits that Commission approval of this request will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity. Favorable action on this request is therefore warranted.
