Grumman Aerospace Corporation requests a Special Temporary Authorization in support U.S. Government Contract # EA-2190F; known as "TAU TEN Transmitters. The proposed station will be located at our Bethpage, NY facility and testing is scheduled to begin April 1, 1995.

Contractual requirements dictate that GAC design, field test, and deliver a HF/UHF/VHF communication system (for use with newly purchased US Navy E2T aircraft) to the Taiwanese R.O.C.A.F.

This radio station will need multiple frequencies in the above mentioned frequency bands for acceptance testing. (Frequencies authorized for KS2XDR-File # s-1448-EX-93 would suffice.)

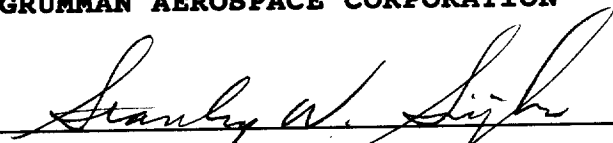
All pertinent RF equipment information, antenna statistics, and Environmental Impact statements are attached.
