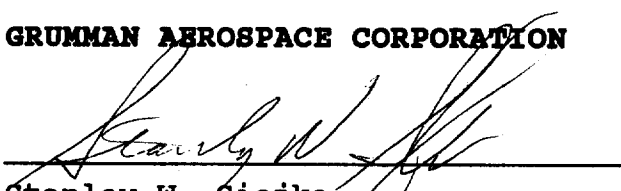
Dear Sir,

Enclosed are FCC 405 renewal applications for radio stations **KF2XCI**, **KQ2XHP**, and **KF2XEE**. As per our telephone conversation last week, I had found typographical errors each of the previously submitted applications and notified you of this finding.

In support of radio station **KF2XEE**, the required FAA Coordination Number given to this application by the FAA Eastern Region is **NEA931005**. A condition requested by the FAA in granting this coordination is that when MODE C type information is transmitted on 1090 MHZ it would seen as **600 feet and below or 60,000 feet or above** to avoid problems with their C.A.S. (Collision Avoidance) system.
