Special Conditions:

- (1) Harris Corporation should be aware that the band 2200-2290 MHz is allocated for federal satellite and fixed line-sight operations. Non-federal use is on a case-by-case basis. Harris Corporation should have no expectations of automatic approval in this band in future submissions.
- (2) Harris Corporation should be aware that due to the geographic location of this application, NTIA is concerned that the potential for interference with Canadian national licensees is a possibility and that should interference occur, NTIA expects Harris Corporation to adhere to the standard restrictions/conditions as if interference with an authorized US licensee had occurred.
