U.S. government agencies that use the 225-400 MHz band have questioned your request of a 10 MHz bandwidth for the frequencies 288.2 and 322.7 MHz. They believe that is excessive. Most assignments in the band use bandwidths of 6 kHz. Either change your requested bandwidth or submit a justification for the 10 MHz bandwidth.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 18, 2005 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
