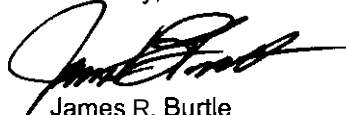
Dear Scott Mikuen,

This refers to application. File No. 0237-EX-RR-2009, for an experimental authorization

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. STAs cannot be renewed on Form 405. The system should not have allowed you to do it, but since the last filing under this application's call sign was an assignment of a license, a glitch in the system software did mistakenly allow the filing. That being said, STAs are supposed to be temporary in nature; this experiment has already had two six-month operations. If you will affirm that the experiment will be over in the next six months, we will allow you to file one more extension using the STA filing option. If the experiment is expected to last longer than another six months, you will need to file a Form 442 for a regular experimental license. You may use one of the previous STAs as a template to minimize data re-entry no matter which option you choose.
