DESCRIPTION OF EXPERIMENT

Consolidated Response to Questions 4 and 5.

Harris is requesting Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to conduct experimental testing in connection with the IEEE 802.16 System Test Plan for the Joint User Interoperability Communications Exercise (JUICE) to be held at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey in June 2008. Further details concerning the Juice experiment are provided in the attached documents.

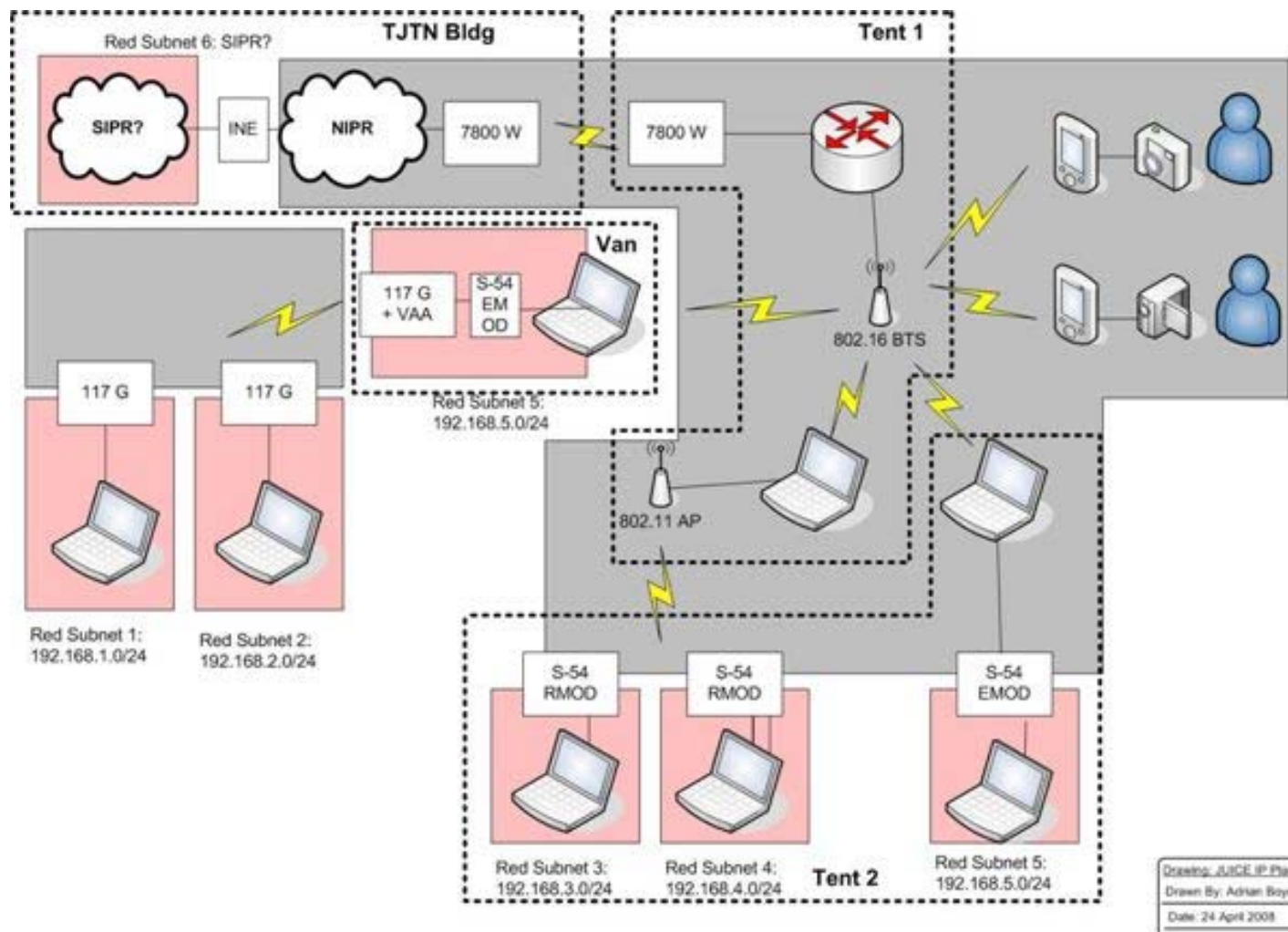
Please note that due to the Army's short turn-around time on this project, expedited processing has been requested. A justification for expedited processing is provided in the attached documents.

Based on the proposed nature of the testing, Harris believes that any potential for interference will be minimized. Harris nonetheless acknowledges that its operations will be on a non-interference basis.

Because the equipment is technically incapable of providing station identification, Harris respectfully requests a waiver of the station identification provisions of Section 5.115 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 5.115.

Harris submits that a grant of an experimental STA is necessary and in the public interest because it will advance the national security efforts identified in the attached documents.
