STA Extension Request**

Harris Corporation ("Harris") hereby submits this request for an extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") issued under Call Sign WD9XCC (File No. 0182-EX-ST-2008). The existing authorization is set to expire on November 13, 2008. Extensive testing pursuant to the experimental authorization continues, and Harris hereby seeks one last additional six month period to continue testing for development and demonstration purposes.

Harris submits that a grant of this request for an extension of STA is necessary and in the public interest because it will advance national security efforts by assisting in the development of a new family of radio communications equipment for use by military, government, and public safety organizations, based on the emerging Wireless Metropolitan Area Network (MAN) technology that is standardized in the IEEE 802.16-2004 and 802.16e-2005 standards. Harris acknowledges that any development of WiMAX type devices needs to occur in an FCC-approved band.

Harris acknowledges that an additional FCC grant of this STA extension is deemed temporary in nature. Furthermore, beyond the requested extension term herein, Harris does not foresee making any further requests seeking extension of this STA.

For the foregoing reason, Harris hereby requests an extension of STA until May 13, 2009.
