The Special Temporary Authority Experimental Authorization WD2XYJ, file no. 0435-EX-PL-2006 was issued pursuant to a contract issued by SPAWARSYSCEN Charleston, contract no. N66001-05-D-5040. This authorization expires on May 15, 2007.

SpaWar has now identified additional testing tasks which require extension of this authorization. "Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, Charleston (SPAWARSYSCEN-CH), has been tasked by the United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM) Psychological Warfare (PSYOP) Division to develop and test enhancements to the Amplitude Modulated (AM) and Frequency Modulated (FM) radio transmitting systems. SPAWARSYSCEN-CH has selected the Naval Air Facility (NAF) El Centro, California as the Radio Frequency (RF) Test Range to conduct these tests." This application requests modification of the license and extension to the expiration date of the new contract, September 14, 2007.

The tests and test procedure are unchanged from the description in the original application. Extension of the authorization will allow tests of additional U.S. military equipment configurations, as well as tests of equipment under development by SpaWar and the licensee pursuant to the contract and task order descriptions.

As described in the narrative exhibit for this application, the frequencies requested have been modified to minimize the potential for interference to any authorized operating FM broadcast stations or translators.
