

## EXHIBIT: Statement of Government Agency Contract Information and Explanation of Technical Characteristics of Proposed Tests

The proposed Special Temporary Authority Experimental Authorization is being requested pursuant to a contract issued by SPAWARSYSCEN Charleston SC J022, contract no. N65236-06-P-2198, Task Order 0001: "SPAWAR has been tasked by USSOCOM to develop and test enhancements to AM and FM radio transmitter systems."

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The tests proposed will consist of operation of existing military and commercial rapid deployment antenna systems and the associated antennas, including equipment for multiple frequency VHF FM broadcast band transmission developed by SPAWAR San Diego.

The antenna mast to be used will be lower in height than that previously authorized for WD2XUM at this same location. Therefore the airspace analysis performed for that authorization is valid for this one as well, and these temporary structures do not require antenna tower registration.

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
