Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation requires consent of affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees.
- (2) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (3) Operation in the 1695-1780 MHz, 1915-1920 MHz, 1995-2020 MHz or 2110-2200 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (4) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (5) Operation in the 824-849 or 869-894 MHz band requires consent of local cellular licensee(s) to avoid interference.
