- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.152 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (3) The grant of this license covers the following applications: 6178-EX-PL-1998 and S-3419-EX-1998.
- (4) This authorization is granted for the purpose of operating radio frequency devices (unintentional radiators) to determine quality, performance, and customer acceptance. These devices are not authorized under part 15 of the FCC rules at the present time and may not be marketed without FCC authorization.
- (5) Licensee is required to file a PROGRESS REPORT every 6 months from the date of original grant. This progress report shall be filed with the Federal Communications Commission; Experimental Licensing Branch, MS 1300E1; 445 12 Street, S.W.; Washington, DC 20554.
- (6) Licensee is authorized to operate devices at up to 25 residential locations.
