Special Conditions:

- (2) NTIA's concurrence is based upon the expectation that the authorized emission bandwidth shall be so located within the band that any emissions will not extend beyond the upper or lower limits of the requested band in this application.
- (3) Operation in the 37,000 - 40,000 MHz band must comply with the unwanted emission power levels of ITU Resolution 243 (WRC-19).
- (4) Licensee must successfully secure consents from the Upper Microwave Flexible Use Service licensees in the proposed area prior to accessing to 37-40 GHz band.
- (5) Licensee must successfully secure consents from the Advanced Wireless Service licensees in the proposed area prior to accessing to frequencies from 2110 MHz to 2180 MHz.
