This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

The purpose of the STA is to test Tarana broadband wireless equipment in the 3300-3550 MHz and 3700-3800 MHz bands to evaluate propagation and capacity performance.

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Special Conditions:
