"Three of the locations list a range of altitudes. It is assumed that these are all mobile airborne tests. The Northrop Grumman site just lists one height on a rooftop. Is this fixed or airborne mobile testing?"

Apologies for any confusion here.

It is correct that a range of altitudes are specified to support mobile airborne testing.

The Northrop Grumman test site is a fixed altitude, as it will apply to a single building rooftop but will be a mobile installation in that it may be moved on the rooftop to a location that best suits the demonstration.

The system is mobile in nature and can be easily moved and removed for demonstration and testing purposes.
