Special Conditions:

- (3) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by US Coast Guard contract DTCG23-02-C-2DW001. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (4) Until such time that the National Security Cutter can be modified to allow the transponder altitude to be set to the altitudes of 1000 feet below mean sea level or more than 90000 feet above mean sea level, any in-port testing requires coordination with the Federal Aviation Administration Eastern Service Area Frequency Management Office (FAA ESA FMO), Ben Phimsoutham, 404-305-6675, at least 24 hours in advance. The times for testing shall be at the discretion of the FAA ESA FMO and operations shall be suspended upon notification. All other testing will be conducted at least 186 km or 100 NM from the coast.
- (5) Subject to coordination with the Gulf Area Frequency Coordinator located at Eglin AFB, Florida, prior to use within the area bounded by 24 N 33 30'N and 83 W 90 W.
- (6) The pulse duration shall be 0.45 usec.
