

US Government Project Contract Number

The University of Illinois is performing research for the Federal Aviation Administration and others. The project name is Bird RADAR Deployment and Testing in the National Bird Strike Advisory System. This FAA research and development program AAR 411 with a Department of Defense program led by U.S. Navy SPAWAR Systems Division. As part of this project, the University will deploy marine RADAR units at fixed land locations for testing within the scope of operation. A special temporary authority is required since the marine RADAR units are not typically authorized for fixed land base use.

The Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois originally held license WD2XZD. This authority was originally granted under the requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration Research and Development Program AAR 411, Grant A5578 DOT 05-C-AT-UIUC Center for Excellence for Airport Technology. The Board respectfully request Experimental Licensing under the same contract.
