The documents are now readable, but the technical data have still not been filled out. Is the 24.15 GHz frequency what the equipment is designed for, or is it the frequency you are going to off-tune to? We need to know what frequency you are actually going to operate at. We also need the Effective Radiated Power (ERP), bandwidth and emission data. Bandwidth and emission are defined Part 2.202 and 2.201, respectively, of the FCC Rules. These rules can be found at <http://www.fcc.gov/oet/info/rules/>. After you have gathered these data, return to the Experimental Licensing System filing site at <https://gullfoss2.fcc.gov/prod/oet/cf/els/index.cfm> and use the "Amend/Complete Application" link to enter these data.
