You recently changed the frequency that I had coordinated with federal government users from 20 GHz to 19.625-20.375 GHz. In one of your exhibits, you said that the operating frequency was 20 GHz +/- 75 MHz, so I entered it as 20 GHz with a frequency tolerance of 0.375% ($75 \times 10^6 \times 100 / 20 \times 10^9$). I sent those parameters over to be coordinated with federal government users. DoD has had it tabled for EMC analysis for quite awhile now. I cannot re-coordinate it with a bandwidth of 750 MHz (19.625-20.375 GHz), even if you truly meant it, because that amount of spectrum crosses into even more frequency allocation bands than what I had coordinated it for. Please advise on whether I can leave the frequency request as I what I have already coordinated.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 06, 2005 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
