IncNETWORKS' program of research and experimentation will develop and test prototype enterprise (in-building and campus) wireless communications systems using small distributed base stations with software defined radio technology for voice, data, and multimedia traffic. These systems are intended to work with a variety of mobile devices (e.g., cellular and PCS telephones, PDAs, laptop computers). Cellular and PCS frequencies will be reused efficiently, enabling new wireless services and coverage within congested corporate campuses and other problematic enterprise locations. This program is an extension and expansion of some of the experimental work previously conducted by incNETWORKS for enterprise wireless communications systems (under call sign, WC2XUL).

The objective of this program is to demonstrate in the incNETWORKS New Jersey headquarters the feasibility of such enterprise wireless communications systems, and to test the incorporation of additional wireless technologies (e.g., voice over IP, GPRS, 4th generation CDMA).

This license request is specifically targeted at testing in GSM frequency bands in use in Europe and Asia in order to expand the potential market for incNETWORKS' systems outside of the United States.
