Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent acts, and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions and requirements set forth in this license, the licensee hereof is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting facilities hereinafter described for radio communications in accordance with the program of experimentation described by the licensee in its application for license.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) The purpose of the licensed operations is to test and verify the proper operation of radars on board Venezuelan naval frigates which are being overhauled, pursuant to:
(1) the contract between Ingalls Shipbuilding and the Government of Venezuela and
(2) the export-import license (# 827654) issued by the U.S. Department of State.
This license terminates at the earliest of: (1) the expiration date shown at the bottom of page one of this license; (2) the date that Ingalls Shipbuilding delivers the last of the two ships to the Government of Venezuelan; or (3) the date of termination of any of the two instruments listed above.
- (4) Licensee must coordinate with all affected FCC licensees prior to operation.
