Dale,

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) gives you permission to test the RAN 11L radar on 1329 MHz. The test will be performed between 0500 and 0900 zulu time with coordination with Houston ARTCC (ZHU) as the focal point of the other FAA ARTCC that will be effect by your test. Dates of the test should be coordinate with ZHU personnel in accordance with the TELCON held on December 14, 2000.

A point of contact (POC) must be provided with phone numbers provide. These must be commercial numbers.

A final written response will be mailed to you after January 2001. This should be enough for you to file a STA request with the FCC.
