Exhibit - Explanation of Modification Application

By this modification of license application, IntegriNautics is requesting permission to move its operations. First, it no longer has need of a license to operate in Nashville, so that location may be deleted.

Secondly, due to business necessity, IntegriNautics needs to move its corporate headquarters to more effective space. This prompts the move of the Palo Alto location to a new space in Menlo Park. The actual distance is less than three miles, but the move is necessitated by business constraints.

Thirdly, the license to be added in San Jose is a new model airfield. This is the location where much of the field testing of the IntegriNautics transmitters will take place. The new field is a far more effective environment for the testing, and IntegriNautics is seeking authorization from the FCC to move to the new site to enhance the effectiveness of its field trials.

The rest of the licensed locations are fine as currently licensed.
