This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Prior to operation, experimental licensee must coordinate with Part 25 licensees authorized to operate in these frequency band that are located within a 25 mile radius of the transmitter.
