Special Conditions:

- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) All of the experimental devices will be under control of Intel Corp. and they will be retrieved by Intel Corp. from the participants upon completion of the experiment.
- (5) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas prior to operation in this band.
- (6) Maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Sub-part Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz band.
- (7) Intel Corp. must coordinate its operations in 3550-3700 MHz band with one or more authorized Spectrum Access System (SAS) administrators to obtain channel assignments and avoid causing harmful interference to authorized users of the band, including General Authorized Access (GAA) users.
- (8) Intel Corp. shall coordinate with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in the proposed areas in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in 3700-3800 MHz band.
- (9) With respect to operations in 3700-3800 MHz band, Intel Corp. should be made aware that they must avoid causing interference to existing Fixed Service operators and FSS earth stations in the band.
