Dear FCC Examiner, This is a follow-up regarding Correspondence Reference No. 104904, a reminder notice for the FAA pre-coordination requirement referenced in Application File No. 1467-EX-ST-2026 (frequencies 5151–5249 MHz). On August 5, 2026, in response to the original correspondence (Reference No. 103985), we submitted a request for guidance regarding the applicable FAA pre-coordination process and the specific documentation required to satisfy this item, as we had not identified an applicable FAA coordination document for this operation. We have not yet received a substantive response to that request. To provide relevant context: the proposed operation is a short-term, indoor demonstration and testing event in support of a Bluetooth SIG interoperability event, involving Bluetooth Higher Bands devices in the 5151–5249 MHz range. Intel Corporation is the grantee owner of record under FCC Grantee Code PD9. Given the indoor nature and limited duration of this operation, we would appreciate clarification on whether the FAA pre-coordination requirement applies to this specific operational profile and, if so, the appropriate process and documentation for satisfying it. We respectfully request guidance at your earliest convenience so that we may respond appropriately within the applicable deadline. Thank you for your assistance.
