I am writing with regard to two applications for
Experimental Radio authorizations filed on behalf of
International Mobile Machines Corporation ("IMM").

On March 13, 1990, IMM filed two Experimental Radio
applications: A modification application to relocate to
Gulph Mills, Pennsylvania, Call Sign KA2XTF; and a renewal
application for Call Sign KA2XVT.

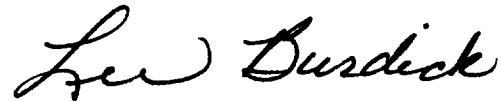
At the end of May, you informed me that these
applications had been granted and were awaiting the issuance
of the authorizations. When we had not received the licenses
by August, we contacted your office and were told that, due
to an oversight, the authorizations had not been issued yet,
but would be forthcoming.

applications to our knowledge. Due to the uncertainty now
associated with its authorizations, IMM hereby seeks the
expedited grant of its applications.

Dear Ms. Searcy:

On behalf of International Mobile Machines Corporation ("IMM"), we hereby submit and original and two copies of an application for authorization to operate in the Experimental Radio Service under Part 5 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

Currently IMM is authorized to test and develop its "Ultraphone" system at its headquarters located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. This operation is authorized under IMM's national experimental license, call sign KA2XTF. As we could not locate the most recent license for this site, a copy of the renewal application filed February 13, 1989, is attached as Exhibit IV for your reference.

IMM will be relocating its Pennsylvania offices in the next two months. By this application, IMM seeks authority to continue its experimental radio operations at the new location in Gulph Mills, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, which is approximately seven miles from its current site. After a short period of transition in which IMM can be sure that its relocated facilities are fully operational, IMM anticipates turning back its license for the Philadelphia site to the Commission.

IMM respectfully requests a two-year authorization at the new site so that it can continue the development of its advanced, spectrally efficient digital/TDMA technology. Grant of the instant application is in the public interest as it would encourage the rapid deployment of new, efficient communications technologies that can accommodate more users while placing less demand on scarce spectrum resources.
