- (4) This frequency assignment in one of the bands 1435-1525, 2310-2320 and 2345-2390 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the HQ USAF Frequency Coordinator, Alexandria, VA., who also coordinated it, as appropriate, with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the HQ USAF Frequency Coordinator, Alexandria, VA., as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (5) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (6) Operation in the 1710-1755 or 2110-2155 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (7) Altitude not to exceed 4,000 ft above AGL.
- (8) 2345-2360 MHz have been re-allocated on a primary basis to the Wireless Communications Service (WCS). Additional coordination with WCS may be required.
- (9) For frequency band 1370-1390 MHz, Pulse Repetition Rate is 70K pps.
