ITT Communications Systems, pending approval of this application, will conduct a series of experiments with our new SpearNet and SNVM radio equipment. The purpose of the experiment is to:

- 1) Confirm performance of the equipment against the manufacturers specifications
- 2) Familiarize ITT personnel in the operation of the equipment
- 3) Rehearse scripted equipment demonstrations in support of marketing activities

Towards that end, a base station antenna will be established at the sight listed in the application, namely; Fort Wayne, IN. Mobile antennas will then be deployed within a 50 km radius of the base stations.

The communications will be voice and digital data.

Upon successful conclusion of the experiments, the equipment will be offered for sale worldwide, subject to US export regulations.
