

REQUEST FOR EXPERIMENTAL LICENSE

Pursuant to Sections 5.3(j) and 5.51(a) of the Commission's rules, Joby Aero, Inc. ("Joby"), requests a new experimental license covering the same experimental operations currently authorized Special Temporary Authority ("STA") WS9XHC.¹ As set forth below, favorable action on this request will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Joby develops and manufactures major aircraft components. Joby obtained an STA and now seeks a license in order to test and evaluate the performance characteristics of aircraft radio equipment manufactured by Advanced Microwave Products (Model# VST1). Flight tests typically are one hour in duration and utilize the frequencies in the areas specified in the STA authorization up to a maximum altitude of 15,000 feet above mean sea level. Test equipment is operated only in one aircraft at a time for each location, though multiple aircraft may operate the equipment on any given day. Flight testing is an integral and necessary component of Joby's ongoing efforts to obtain FAA flight certification for new aircraft technology it is developing.

Joby has frequency coordinated the subject operations with the Aerospace & Flight Test Radio Coordination Council ("AFTRCC"), which obtained concurrence from the Department of Defense. In addition, evidence of FAA frequency coordination also is attached. Joby understands that its operations will be on a non-interference basis to current authorized users within radio line-of-sight and will suspend its operations in the event harmful interference occurs. Continued access to this spectrum for experimental operations is needed to enable Joby's ongoing operations and testing, which in turn will aid Joby in the continued development of new aircraft technology of potential future benefit to the public.
