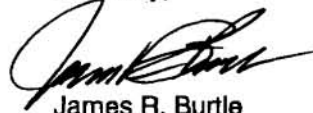
Dear David G. Joseph,

This refers to application, File No. 0174-EX-PL-2007, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. The operation proposed in this experiment can not be used to broadcast to the general public. There are a number of 1 kW and 5 kW DRM operations in the 26 MHz band in Europe, and since it would seem reasonable to assume that there had been plenty of DRM transmission testing done in past, the information from that testing should have already been obtained and used in determining if DRM is a feasible means of communication.
