This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. - (5) Operation is subject to consent of the following within 50 miles of the test area:
 - o SMR licensees (806-821 MHz/851-866 MHz)
- (6) Operation is subject to notification of the following within 50 miles of the test area:
 - o Narrowband PCS licensees (901-902 MHz)
 - o Location & Monitoring Service licensees (902-928 MHz)

- (8) Coordinate with the local SBE frequency coordinator prior to operation in 470-475.999 MHz band.
- (9) Operation is not permitted in 932.650-932.675 MHz.
