SFT Spectrum, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire") is the licensee, is the licensee of BRS Stations WNEK346 (BRS Channel H1, 002650.00000-002656.00000 MHz) and WHJ893 (BRS Channel H2, 002662.00000-002668.00000 MHz), which covers Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Clearwire hereby consents to KenCast, Inc.'s temporary use of that spectrum in conjunction with its short-term demonstration. As explained to us, the demonstration of KenCast's service will take place at the LANDWARNET annual trade show in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. KenCast will use the spectrum from August 18 through August 21, 2008.

By our signature below, Clearwire consents to KenCast's use of the BRS spectrum on a temporary basis for the above-described equipment demonstration purposes. Our consent is contingent on KenCast operating on the spectrum in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, and its taking all necessary steps to cause no interference to any current operations and the status of the license and lease. KenCast further agrees to indemnify Clearwire against any damages caused by KenCast's temporary operation of the spectrum, including, without limitation, the payment of any fines levied by the FCC or other regulatory authority for any improper use of the spectrum, such as interference with other channels. Without limiting the foregoing, by its reliance on this consent, KenCast agrees to provide Clearwire a local contact person and number during the trade show who can be immediately reached in the event of interference, and to immediately cease any use of any of the channels upon request of Clearwire, until any interference issues that might arise are resolved to their satisfaction.
