This Experimental Authorization would replace a prior experimental license, WC2XKT, which permitted product quality assurance initiatives concerning the entire product line of Kenwood land mobile transceivers. The company's Suwanee, Georgia headquarters facility wishes to test its products prior to marketing. The authorization specifies the frequency bands and emission modes used at the present time which corresponds to current products of Kenwood USA Corporation (Communications Division). These devices will be operated at the address specified and in the immediate vicinity of the Kenwood facility. They will be operated for testing purposes only, which tests will be related to quality control, and all operation will be by Kenwood employees at this location.

Kenwood accepts the same condition that was attached to the prior experimental authorization for this same purpose: that operation in the specified bands is limited to existing channels and frequency allocations under part 90 of the Commission's rules.

The Research and Development Manager, Don Wingo, will serve as the "stop buzzer" contact in case of any interference allegations. All operation will cease in such a situation until the interference is resolved to the satisfaction of any licensee of the Commission.
