Hello,

In your correspondence you asked if we could reduce the number of devices for this experiment. We prefer not to, and this is the reason why. This experiment is to be the largest regional test of UHF technology performance for last-mile connectivity in the United States to date. It leverages an existing ARRA funded middle-mile network to connect UHF devices across the Northern Tier of Pennsylvania -- covering more than 25 counties. The experiment will test UHF device coverage, capacity, application support, interference mitigation using Spectrum Bridge software, etc. The experiment aims to confirm or question UHF technology viability as a regional last-mile solution in a very difficult, rural environment, where many other technologies have failed.

You also noted that the application was submitted to be confidential. That was not the intent. We would like to change it, but cannot find a means to make the change using the amend/complete application option on the website. Please provide directions on how to amend the confidentiality button and we will do it.

Lastly, we will submit payment after making the changes.
