Dear Glenn Ichel,

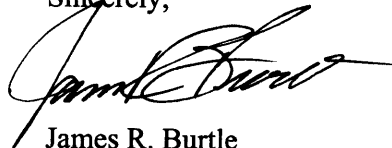
This refers to application, File No. 0243-EX-PL-2003, for Experimental Radio Station WD2XGM.
