L-3 Communications Systems West ("L-3 Comm" or "Applicant") hereby submits an original and two (2) copies of the application on FCC Form 442 for a new Experimental Radio Service authorization to conduct field trials and acceptance testing of a 3.5 GHz Fixed Wireless Loop (FWL) system.
