This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

- (3) Operation must be coordinated with the existing users prior to use bands 71-76 GHz and 81-86 GHz.
- (4) Operation requires consent of affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees in the bands 2500-2570 MHz and 2620-2690 MHz.
- (5) Further requests for extension of the authority granted herein must be filed on Form 442, "Application for New or Modified Radio Station Authorization under Part 5 of FCC Rules - Experimental Radio Service." Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
