Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent acts, and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions and requirements set forth in this license, the licensee hereof is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting facilities hereinafter described for radio communications in accordance with the program of experimentation described by the licensee in its application for license.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Operation is limited to activity for the purpose of testing radionavigation satellite service (RNSS) equipment and systems.
- (4) The test equipment shall only be used indoors and shall be under the control of L3 Communications.

Special Conditions:

- (5) L3 Communications shall post signs on doors to the test area notifying that, "GPS re-radiator is in use and the GPS information you receive may be in error."
- (6) GPS users in the area of potential interference to GPS reception must be notified that GPS information may be impacted for periods of time.

- (8) Assignment in frequency bands 960-1400, 2700-2900, or 9000-9200 MHz is subject to further coordination with the FAA Southwest Coordinator, Ft. Worth, TX. Use of frequencies under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Southwest Coordinator, Ft. Worth, TX, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
