

Supplemental Submission Regarding Applicant Ownership

Pursuant to a number of applications, the FCC has approved the proposed transfer of control of L3 to Harris Corporation. See FCC File Nos. 0003-EX-TU-2019, 0005-EX-TU-2019, 0007-EX-TU-2019, 0008-EX-TU-2019, 0009-EX-TU-2019, 0011-EX-TU-2019, 0012-EX-TU-2019, 0016-EX-TU-2019, 0018-EX-TU-2019, 0019-EX-TU-2019, 0020-EX-TU-2019, & 0021-EX-TU-2019 (the "Approved Applications").

On Saturday, June 29, Harris and L3 consummated the approved merger pursuant to these approvals.

At the time of consummation, this application was pending. The merger does not change the name of the applicant. However, it does change the party ultimately in control of the applicant. Following the consummation of the merger, Harris Corporation, which is now known as L3Harris Technologies, Inc. ("L3Harris"), is the party ultimately in control of the applicant, as set forth in the Approved Applications.
