

L3Harris Technologies, Inc. (“Licensee”) hereby requests a new license for one year to continue emissions needed to develop and test waveforms for use in both current and future L3Harris communications equipment at its Rochester, New York location on frequencies in the FR1 N77 Sub Band of the “C” frequency band. This application is being filed to continue the operations currently authorized under Special Temporary Authority (File No. 0143-EX-ST-2026) under call sign WA9XSI, which expires on August 16, 2026.

Because the equipment is technically incapable of providing station identification, L3Harris respectfully requests a waiver of the station identification provisions of Section 5.115 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 5.115. All network traffic will be simulated traffic only, solely for evaluation purposes and not for the purpose of providing network data communications services to user stations.

L3Harris submits that a grant of this License request is necessary and in the public interest, as it will advance national security efforts by contributing and assisting in the further development of communications equipment utilized by the U.S. Armed Forces.
