This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Further requests for extension of the authority granted herein must be filed on Form 442, "Application for New or Modified Radio Station Authorization under Part 5 of FCC Rules - Experimental Radio Service." Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
- (4) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Franklin Williams at (801) 594-7341.
- (5) Licensee must successfully coordinate with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in the proposed venue in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in 5.925-6.425 GHz and 30-31 GHz bands.
- (6) The terminals will be only pointing at the following locations in the GSO arc: -52.52 and -135.19 E. Any modifications will necessitate that Navy review this application again.
- (7) Every Band/ED on the application is a single carrier (for the respective band) or Group BW=necessary BW in the ED.
- (8) Terminals' antenna patterns are modeled after typical VSAT for X- and Ka- (overlapping) bands.
- (9) Prior to testing in the 7.9-8.4 GHz and 30-31 GHz bands over Wideband Global SATCOM (WGS), the Federal sponsored POC (USSTRATCOM) for this effort should submit WGS Satellite Access Request (SAR) and receive approval for accessing to WGS.
- (10) The RF parameters for any testing under this authorization should match the ones listed in the Satellite Access Authorization (SAA).
- (11) Licensee is authorized to conduct tests on a 2.4m (Terminal #1: Hawkey III) Via Galaxy 28 satellite in the 5925-6425 MHz and 14-14.5 GHz, and via AMC-15 satellite in the 14-14.5 GHz band.
- (12) Point of communication: Intelsat/Viasat's Galaxy 28 satellite @ 89 WL (Call Sign: S2160), SES' AMC-15 satellite @105.05 WL (Call Sign: S2180), WGS satellite.

Special Conditions:

- (13) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.
- (14) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract number FA8612-21-C-5007. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (15) Licensee is not authorized to operate in the 5.85-5.925 GHz and 13.75-14.0 GHz band.
