We request the confidentiality Clause would be withdrawn from our application FCC File No. 0160-EX-PL-2008. The confidentiality request was selected inadvertently in the application and LaPoint Blasé Industries, Inc. does not wish to request confidentiality for this application.

2. Please explain for use of a 60-month experimental license as opposed to a 24-month experimental license.

The hydrological study that this radar will be supporting is a 5-year research project funded by the National Science Foundation. At the end of the 5-year study, the radar is anticipated to be removed from service or to be replaced with a permanent unit that will be licensed as a non-experimental system.

3. Under the Experimental Description, you have stated that your experiment's location is in Houston, Texas. But you have filed for two locations under this application, Saint Louis, MO and Houston, TX. You are already authorized to conduct experiment in St. Louis, MO (FCC File No. 0705-EX-PL-2007), if this is an error please confirm so this location can be removed from the pending application (FCC File No. 0160-EX-PL-2008).

The pending application should only be applied to the new location in Houston, TX. The existing license (FCC File No. 0705-EX-PL-2007) should be retained for St. Louis, MO. It is acceptable to remove the St. Louis location from the pending license.
